<u>Plant Dane Native Plant Sale 2025</u>- Order system opened Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> and species must be ordered in quantities of 4. 50+ species available including garden kits. Order at <u>https://www.ripple-effects.com/Plant-Dane</u>.

- Cost \$3/plant or \$12/4-pack, \$44 for 16 plant kits and \$88 for 32-plant kits

<u>Free Native Plants for School and Community Groups Grant-</u> We accepted 42 applications for the spring cycle from: Madison, Middleton, Monona, Mount Horeb, McFarland, Town of Dunn, Oregon, Waunakee, Stoughton, Sun Prairie, DeForest, and Fitchburg. Approved projects have been posted on Plant Dane Order site for people to donate to and promo materials were shared with applicants to encourage donations. **Dig Into Rain Gardens-1:1 Coaching Sessions** –30 min. one-on-one sessions will be offered from 8am -1pm, **Sun., March 2<sup>nd</sup>** at the Dane County LWRD Office, 5201 Fen Oak Dr., Madison. Participants will meet individually with a rain garden expert to look at their specific site using an online mapping application, determine drainage patterns and select an optimal location for a rain garden. Experts will also assist participants with sizing, plant selection and provide resources on site preparation and installation. Cost is \$20/session. Residents in MAMSWaP communities are eligible to receive up to a \$50 reimbursement for Plant Dane plants once proof of rain garden installation is received. <u>Storm Drain Murals 2025</u>- We've received two applications for new storm drain murals near Aldo Leopold Elem.-Madison and Park Elem.-Cross Plains and interest from Stoughton. Applications will be accepted until Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>. We can paint up to four new murals and five repaints this year. Repaints were selected based on the condition inventory conducted in 2023.

**FREE Nature In Session: Stormwater Exploration Classes-** We are partnering with Lussier Family Heritage Center on a new Nature in Session Program that brings natural resources education to schools and libraries, ages

1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade. Classes are normally \$50/group (up to 30 people). MAMSWaP is offering a limited number of FREE Stormwater sessions for schools and libraries in MAMSWaP communities.

Free MAMSWaP Stormwater Program Details:

-max of 20 classes offered in 2025

-limited to 3 class programs per MAMSWaP community/year

-MAMSWaP Communities can apply once every three years to allow other communities opportunities.
