# Leaf-free Streets for Clean Waters Summary- Final numbers for 2022

- 560 text rain alert subscribers (57 new in 2022), 464 email rain alert subscribers (32 new in 2022)
- 5 rain alert issued in 2022 (10/10, 10/23, 11/3, 11/9, 11/14)
- 151 Leaf-free Streets signs requested by groups and individuals

A survey was sent to all Leaf-free Streets Rain Alert subscribers in Dec. 94 surveys were completed. Feedback was very positive.

- 87% of respondents attempted to remove leaves for at least half of the storms.
- Main reasons for not removing leaves- no leaves present, ran out of time.
- 35% noticed some or many neighbors also removing street leaves before the rain.
- 88% found the alerts useful or very useful
- 94% want to continue to receive alerts

<u>Rain Barrel Program Summary</u>- Rain barrel sales for 2022 closed Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>. Rain barrels will be available to order again in April 2023.

<u>Plant Dane 2023</u>- Prices for 2023 are 2.75/plant, up from 2.35/plant 2022. Due to the continuous growth of the program over the years, **Agrecol is capping our order at 35,000 plants this year including donations**. This is the first time we've had to limit orders so orders will be first come, first served with two pick up dates in May (14<sup>th</sup> am and 24<sup>th</sup> pm). Please encourage residents to order early to ensure availability. We will accept donations for Free Native Plant Projects as part of Plant Dane as we have in the past. <u>Dig Into Rain Gardens-1:1 Coaching Sessions</u> — We are offering 30 minute one-on-one rain garden coaching sessions for Dane County residents this spring. 24 sessions will be offered from 8am -12pm, Sat., March 4<sup>th</sup> at the Dane County LWRD Office, 5201 Fen Oak Dr., Madison. Participants will meet individually with a rain garden expert to look at their specific site using an online mapping application, determine drainage patterns and select an optimal location for a rain garden. Experts will also assist participants with sizing, plant selection and provide resources on site preparation and installation. Cost is \$20/session with potential to receive up to a \$50 reimbursement for Plant Dane plants once proof of install is received. <u>Free Native Plants for School and Community Groups Grant</u>- 32 applications were submitted during the spring cycle.
