Rain Barrel Program 2023- We are accepting rain barrel orders again this spring thru the end of October. -Order system opened this week. Supply of 80 barrels from 2022 is down to 13.

-Cost remains the same as in 2022, \$74 with an additional \$30 reimbursement for residents in MAMSWaP communities.
