<u>Spring Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Events</u> - Four HHW disposal events were held at Clean Sweep this spring. Events were only open to residents of participating communities. Participants pre-registered for a \$5 (normally \$15/vehicle) voucher to dispose of household hazardous waste to use during open Clean Sweep hours the week of their assigned event. All items that Clean Sweep accepts including small electronics and up to one TV, computer monitor, or microwave were be accepted. Outreach materials were shared with each community to promote the event locally.

- <u>City of Stoughton:</u> 54 registered/42 attended (78%)
- <u>Town of Middleton:</u> 111 registered/88 attended (79%)
- <u>Village of Windsor:</u> 49 registered/38 attended (78%)
- <u>City of Monona</u>: 72 registered/57 attended (79%)

Hope to continue to offer these events to MAMSWaP communities on a rotating basis so every community has an opportunity every 4-5 years. Events may be moved to the fall starting in 2026.

<u>Illicit Discharge Training for Field Staff-</u> MAMSWaP hosted a free Illicit Discharge Training for MAMSWaP municipal field staff only on Tues., Apr. 15th @ 10AM, Middleton City Hall. The training was led by Logan Prichard, Environmental Protection Specialist with Public Health Madison/Dane County. <u>The presentation was recorded and is available on our MAMSWaP Member's page.</u>
