### Green Infrastructure (GI) Tour

- -Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9am -12:30pm
- -Format will be similar to the 2017 Permeable Pavement Tour bussing to different project locations.
- -5 stops with unique GI practices in Madison and Fitchburg.
- -Registration will be available in late August.

**2024 MAMSWaP Stormwater Outreach/Ed. Survey**- We will be working with UW Extension Evaluation Team at the Natural Resources Institute on our 5-year Stormwater Outreach and Ed. Survey. This is the same group we worked with for the 2018/19 Survey.

-Using same survey as we did in 2018/19 with a few changes to gather data on more recent programs. -Mailed random sample survey that will be distributed to 1500 residents across all our MAMSWaP communities. (Same methods that were used in 2018)

-Goal of a 30% response rate.

-Survey can be completed on paper or online via link in invitation.

-Initial cost estimate is \$32,000. 2018 survey cost about \$23,000.

-Looking into the option of distributing online survey to water related groups, organizations as well and comparing these results to those obtained through the random sample method. Additional cost to analyze and compare results to mailed survey.
